Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir State Rural Livelihoods Mission has been entrusted with the implementation of the Skill Development Programme viz. HIMAYAT by designating it as Action Plan State under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya- Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) financed by Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India;

Whereas, consequent upon the above decision this Mission submitted Action Plan to the Ministry which was approved at a cost of Rs.1601.51 crores with 100 percent Central share from the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India covering a target to skill training and placement of 1,24,180 youth;

Whereas, Project Applications were invited under the programme from prospective Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs) for providing of training and employment to youth;

Whereas, vide Government Order No.257-RD&PR of 2016 dated 07.09.2016 issued by the Department of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Jammu and Kashmir, National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj (NIRD&PR), Hyderabad was engaged as Central Technical Support Agency (CTSA)/Project Appraisal Agency for appraisal/evaluation of proposals of PIAs;

Whereas, Project Applications were appraised and recommended by the National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Hyderabad (NIRD&PR) for providing of training under different trades;

Whereas, the recommendations of the Project Appraisal Agency were placed before the State Level Project Review Committee (SLPRC) in its fourth meeting held on 01-06-2018;

Whereas, NIRD&PR in the meeting confirmed that the PIAs have been appraised and were found fully qualified as per the guidelines of DDU-GKY;

Now, therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to the allotment of Project under HIMAYAT (DDU-GKY) Programme in favour of "M/s Apparel Training and Design Centre" (bearing PRN: DL2014RF3619 and Proposal Code: DL2014RF361920180424123322) for providing training and placement to youth as per the details given below:-

The funds for implementation of the project by the Project Implementing Agency shall be released in instalments in the ratio of 25:50:15:10. Further, the sanction is subject to the following conditions:

1. Funds shall be released after submission of Risk Mitigation Plan against risks identified by Project Appraisal Agency (NIRD&PR).
2. A minimum capacity of training batch commencement has to be at least 20% of the project target.
3. PIA shall ensure the participation of state or district level official from JKSRML or from the district administration in the orientation and screening process held for candidates.

4. PIA shall ensure that a minimum of two counselling sessions are held with each candidate selected for training and one counselling session with either of their parents/guardian.
5. PIA shall furnish a bank guarantee for a minimum value of 6.25% of the total approved project cost in line with notification 50 of 2017 of Department of Rural Development, Ministry of Rural Development.
6. PIA shall ensure that at least 50% of the proposed training centres (residential course) should be located within J&K State and remaining in the neighboring states such as Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Delhi-NCR. For any technical reasons such as unavailability of technical/machine infrastructure within the State and mentioned neighboring states, PIA shall have to apply for relaxation in writing to HMMU for setting up of training centre(s) in other State.
7. Provisions of Guidelines governing the scheme/SOPs of Himayat, DDU-GKY.
8. Other terms and conditions to be specified from time to time.
9. Fulfillment of conditions contained in the Memorandum of Understanding to be inked.
